RESOURCE CONSENT: RM180137 - 3 BEARS RUNNING LIMITED

PUBLIC NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR RESOURCE CONSENT

The Mackenzie District Council have received a resource consent application from 3 Bears Running Limited to subdivide land legally described as Part Rural Section 32380 at Clayton Road, Fairlie into 17 fee simple allotments. The resultant lots range in size from approximately 3017m² to 17,794m². As part of the development, the applicant has applied for land use consent to reduce the internal boundary setbacks on Lots 1 to 17.

The site is zoned Rural in the Operative Mackenzie District Plan 2004 and is subject to the Flood Hazard notation. Vehicle access to Lots 1, 3, 4 and 5 will be provided via a new right of way off Monument Road. Vehicle access to Lot 2 will be directly from Monument Road. Vehicle access to Lot 12 will be directly from Clayton Road and vehicle access to Lots 6 to 11 and Lots 14 to 17 will be from Lot 200 which will be vested with Council as Road.

Overall the application will be assessed as a Discretionary Activity in terms of the provisions of the Operative Mackenzie District Plan.
