Mackenzie District Plan Review: Proposed Plan Changes 28, 29 and 30, Variations, and Designations

Pursuant to Clause 5 of the First Schedule and section 169 of the Resource Management Act 1991, Council gives public notice of proposed Plan Changes, associated Variations, and the Designations Chapter, to the Mackenzie District Plan.

The plan changes concern:

- Plan Change 28 – Hazards and Risks, Historic Heritage and Notable Trees
- Plan Change 29 – Open Space and Recreation Zones, Noise, Signs and Temporary Activities
- Plan Change 30 – Special Purpose Zones

These form Stage 4 of the review of the Mackenzie District Plan and have been drafted in accordance with the National Planning Standards.

The Plan Changes introduce new chapters to the Mackenzie District Plan.

The Plan Changes and Variations introduce zones, overlays, specific control areas and other layers and amendments to the Mackenzie District Plan EPlan Maps.

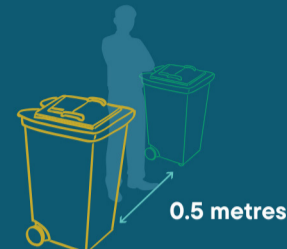
